Technical Capacity Mini-grant recipients have been selected

November 25, 2008 -The Center for Watershed Protection would like to thank all the groups that submitted an application to the Technical Capacity Mini-grant Program. Due to a huge response to the program, the application process was closed October 31st. We received a total of 129 proposals from 40 states across the U.S. A variety of proposal topics were submitted, including stormwater demonstration projects (rain barrels, rain gardens, permeable pavement, etc.), erosion and sediment control, outreach and education, publications, stream restoration, trainings and workshops, water quality monitoring, watershed assessment, and watershed and stormwater management plans. Many of the proposals were exceptional, making the decision to determine which ones to fund a difficult choice. Applications were judged based on how well they met the requirements of the RFP and increased the technical capacity of the group. They were also judged on the extent of their outputs and outcomes. We were looking for proposals that would achieve the greatest impact for the amount of grant money to be awarded.
